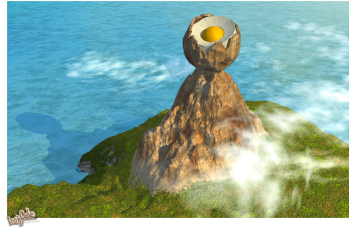


THE ISLE OF EGG

Eco Drama launched its new children's theatre show '**The Isle of Egg**' on the island it was inspired by on **May 2nd & 3rd** at the **Isle of Egg's Giant's Footstep Family Festival**, part of the **NESTA Big Green Challenge**. The play was extremely well received by both children & adults and now begins its tour of Scotland's schools, theatres and community venues.
